Scoring

1. Rally scoring will be used for all games in pool play. The first 2 games will be played to 25 with a cap at 27. Game 3, if necessary, will be played to 15 with a cap at 17. ***In the championship and third place match, there will be NO cap on any set. The first two sets will be played to 25 and the third set to 15.**
2. The second team listed is the visiting team and calls the coin flip. Blue Ridge will always be the home team on the scoreboard.
3. The first through fifth place teams in each pool will be determined by the following procedure:
 - a. Matches won
 - b. Head to head winner
 - c. Games won
 - d. Total points allowed in pool play
 - e. Coin toss by official

**It is not necessary for any competing school to bring volleyballs...Blue Ridge will supply all volleyballs used during the tournament

Warm Up Times

The warm up for a team's first match will be 2-6-6. All other matches will use a 3-3-1 (3 minutes of floor time for each team and 1 minute for serving) format.

Admission

1. One admission will be charged for the entire tournament (Adults \$6....Students \$2)
2. No passes will be honored for this tournament
